Report:

Aim of the event:

The University of Camerino and the European Academy of Bolzano/Bozen – Eurac Research, in collaboration with the Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea – Italian Delegation to the Alpine opportunities offered by different territories to stakeholders and sectors involved in innovation at large (e.g. energy, agri-food industries, manufacturing, tourism, no-profit). The goal is to take stock on a model for instilling green economy and fostering its development in complex areas. In particular, the aim is to create the foundations of a framework for a green development strategy in the Apennine region. The strategy should be coherent with local and global demands, integrated within institutional actions by public bodies and in line with international goals requiring a greening of the economic system in order to be met (e.g. mitigation and adaptation to environmental climate change, reduction of land consumption, shifting of production towards green and organic sectors, biodiversity protection, etc.). The Conference was also an occasion for the dissemination of the Sixth Report on the State of the Alps (RSA 6), coordinated by the German Presidency of the Alpine Convention and published in 2017 by the Permanent Secretariat of the Alpine Convention. The Conference explored the possibility to share the ongoing experience of the Alps and the methods adopted for the Report with the Apennines. The reports revolved around the following three main topics, each one being addressed in a parallel working session:

1. Green economy and natural resources management
2. Green economy and public policies
3. Green economy, finance, jobs and business

Specific SEC ADAPT Partners activity (presentation, participation to workshop, poster etc)

Municipality of Macerata and Jesi together with SVIM presented LIFE SEC Adapt project as one of the good practice of the event, followed by a poster session. We presented the main results of the project up to date (climatic assessment for Marche and Istria Region, vulnerability and risk assessment).

Lesson learnt to spread with LIFE SEC ADAPT partners:

Lot of solutions are already present at International level, from which we all could take inspiration to find solutions for common problems, regarding both adaptation and mitigation.
